Introduction:

- *If you had to live on a deserted island, what are three things (not people) you would take with you? Why?
- *What is one guilty pleasure that you would have a hard time letting go? Why?
- *Do you tend to be a “hoarder” or are you able to let things go easily?

- *How does this passage make you feel?
- *What is Jesus trying to teach us in this passage?

1 Kings 19:19-21

- *Why does Elijah choose Elisha to join him in his ministry?
- *What is Elisha’s response to Elijah?
- *What does Elisha do to his oxen and yoke? Why?
- *What commitment is Elisha making to Elijah? What can we learn from this?

When you hear the words “surrender all” in reference to our relationship with Jesus what do you think? Is it truly possible to “surrender all” to Jesus? Why or why not?

A follower of Jesus “goes where Jesus goes”. What does this look like in our culture today? What does this look like in your own life?

We can follow Jesus beginning from where we are right now. Why do some people feel like they have to be perfect before they start following Jesus? How can we teach people differently?
